


Andrea Orozco

BECKY'S JOURNEY


Growing up in a close-knit mobile home community in Phoenix, Becky and her family of six shared a humble home filled with love and resilience. Her parents, hardworking and selfless, faced constant financial struggles but shielded their children from worry, teaching them that education was their path to a better life. Becky learned early that her family's sacrifices and dreams were intertwined with her own – that by chasing her education, she could bring hope and possibility back to those she loved most.



When Becky joined Boys Hope Girls Hope in sixth grade, her world opened in ways she had never imagined. For the first time, she felt a path unfold before her—one of hope for her future.

"I'm not just working for my own future—I'm working for my family, to show my siblings that our story can be different. I want to prove that no matter where you start, there's always a way forward if you keep hoping and pushing through."

Becky graduated from Xavier College Preparatory, where she thrived academically, which led her to receiving a Dorrance Scholarship. This prestigious award provides \$12,000 a year for four years to first-generation college students in Arizona. Becky accepted the scholarship and is currently in her senior year at Arizona State University.

"Being accepted into BHGH made me feel like I was chosen for something important. I've always been good at math, and I like solving problems. That's why I want to become an engineer and work on rocket ships at NASA."

Now, Iñake has settled into the program. School can be tough, but he knows he's not alone. The program staff are there to help him with his homework, encourage him when he's struggling, and celebrate his successes.

"Being the first in my family to earn a college degree means everything to me. I want to show my family that all their hard work and support have paid off, and I want to show my siblings that anything is possible if you work hard."
